Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Temporary Closure of: C30 (Part), High Street (Part) and Bagshot Road (Part), Little Bedwyn (Ref: TTRO 5805)

Notice is hereby given that Wiltshire Council has made an Order to close temporarily to all traffic:

Phase 1

C30 (Part), Little Bedwyn; from its junction with High street for a distance of approximately 180 metres in a north easterly direction;

Phase 2

High Street (Part), Little Bedwyn; from its junction with C30 for a distance of approximately 30 metres in a southerly direction;

Phase 3

High Street (Part), little Bedwyn; from its junction with Kelston Road for a distance of approximately 90 metres in a north westerly direction.

Phase 4

High Street (Part), Little Bedwyn; from its junction with Kelston Road to its junction with Bagshot Road;

Bagshot Road (Part), Little Bedwyn; from its junction with High Street for a distance of approximately 550 metres in a southerly direction.

To enable: Scottish and Southern Energy to carry out installation of electricity circuit for network improvements.

Phase 1

Alternative route: via C30 (unaffected length) – A4 – C201 – School Lane – High Street and vice versa.

Phase 2

Alternative route: via C30 – A4 – C201 – School Lane – High Street (unaffected length) and vice versa.

Phase 3

Alternative route: via High Street (unaffected length) – Bagshot Road – Bagshot – A338 – A4 – C30 and vice versa.

Phase 4

Alternative route: via High Street (unaffected length) – Bagshot Road (unaffected length) – Bagshot – A338 – Shalbourne Road – Jockey Green – Brook Street – C30 and vice versa.

The closure and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic signs.

This Order will come into operation on 11 March 2019 and it is anticipated that the closures will be required as follows:

Phase 1: operating 12 March 2019 until 25 March 2019;

Phase 2: operating 25 March 2019 until 28 March 2019;

Phase 3: operating 28 March 2019 until 03 April 2019;
Phase 4: operating 03 April 2019 until 22 May 2019.

It is anticipated that the works will take the stated duration to complete depending upon weather conditions. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses where possible, although delays are likely due to the nature of the works. The order will have a maximum duration of 18 months.
